FOOD SUPPORT

A map of all food projects in Suffolk can be found on the <u>Suffolk Infolink</u> website. If someone needs a food parcel, please ask them to contact Babergh & Mid Suffolk District Council on 0300 123 4 000, option 7 for a referral, or contact their local Citizens Advice.

ENERGY SUPPORT

If a person is unable to heat their home, you can give them contact details for their local Citizens Advice who may be able to apply for charitable assistance.



You can also refer people in need of emergency heating to Warm Homes Healthy People Suffolk for temporary oil filled heaters using their online referral <u>form</u>.

HOUSING SUPPORT

If you speak to someone who is homeless, or at risk of homelessness (including those in unaffordable properties, or properties in poor condition), please ask them them to contact the Housing Solutions Team for further advice and assistance on 0300 123 4 000, option 3, or using the online form

You can also refer a household for support via the <u>Duty to Refer form</u>, if you have consent to share their details.

WANT TO OFFER MORE SUPPORT?

HOUSEHOLD SUPPORT FUND 4

If your organisation would like to hold a fund to support vulnerable people with essentials such as food, water and clothing, you may be able to apply for Suffolk Community Foundation's Household Support Fund 4 grant.

Funds must be spent by April 2024.
